

Avtec Showcases New Transmissions, Engines At Auto Expo Components

Avtec Ltd displayed a number of new transmission components at the Auto Expo Components at Pragati Maidan. The most important display for the company was its new transfer case, which it claims to be more advanced than products currently available in the market. These transfer cases have lower NVH levels and come with electric motors and ECU that will interface with the engine and transmission, said Prabhakar Kadapa Managing Director and CEO, Avtec.

Another product that was showcased was a 1.8 l petrol engine which the company supplies with its partner, Peugeot Citroen Motors. This engine is compliant with Euro V standards and is currently being exported, with a possible future launch in India, Kadapa said. Critical parts of this engine will be manufactured in India, and then be assembled in the country of export.

Avtec also showed its 3.9 l, which can be used for CV applications. This is a Euro IV engine that has been downgraded to Euro III for current norms in the country, Kadapa said, adding that it can be easily scaled back up. The company also displayed a transaxle for passenger cars between 1 and 1.5 l engine capacities.
